

Privacy Policy

TECHFINLEGAL (PTY) Limited (***“TechFinLegal”***) is committed to protecting your personal data. This privacy policy describes why and how we collect and use your personal data when you visit this site.

In order to meet our obligations to you we need to collect personal or other information to service your contractual needs for the service offering(s) you have taken up with us, to follow your instructions, to contact you in the event you have logged a query or complaint via our website, to inform you of new services and to ensure that our business is geared towards your needs. We will not use your information for any other purposes without your consent.

In general ***TechFinLegal*** only collects and processes personal information which you voluntarily provide to us.

Any related information we collect when you use this site, such as domain names, location, pages visited etc., is not to personally identify you. Instead this information is used for analysis purposes to help us improve the website and how it is used.

We will NOT intercept or monitor your communications.

We do link to other websites, and cannot guarantee how your personal information shall be treated by those entities.

We may directly market our products (digital or otherwise) but shall ensure that we act in accordance with the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act and the Protection of Personal Information Act specifically.

We may transfer or disclose the personal data we collect to third party contractors, subcontractors, and/or their subsidiaries and affiliates in order to meet our obligations to you . Examples of third party contractors we use are providers of website hosting and management, data analysis, data backup, security and cloud storage services, and other outsourcing service providers.

By visiting this website or communicating with us by electronic means, you consent to receiving communications automatically and agree that all agreements, notices, disclosures and all other communications transmitted by electronic means satisfies any legal requirement, including but not limited to the requirement that such communication should be “in writing”. On some parts of our website we use so-called “cookie” technology. Cookie technology consists of small pieces of data or a small text file, which is given to your browser by our webserver when you visit our website. This data is stored on your browser.
